



## ***AMERICAN NATIVE HERBAL OINTMENT*** ***Native Ointment (1 oz.)***

### **External Usage**

**A Synergistic Botanical Preparation**

**Other Applications:** Also may be used for all animals.

**Formulation:** Ointment – 1 oz.

**Herbal Ingredients:** Standardized herbal extracts of Red Clover (*Tribolium Pratense*), Sheep Sorrel (*Rumex Acetosella*), Bloodroot (*Sanguinaria Canadensis*), Galangal (*Alpina Official*).

#### **Read Carefully... Use Caution**

Some people report that after using the herbal ointment on the body, there remains a moderate to heavy scar. One way to reduce the scarring is to keep the effected tissues moist with Un-petroleum Multi-purpose Jelly, throughout the entire procedure.

**Herbal Ointment** is very potent. Do not assume that if a little works more will be better. Use a small dose and increase only if it seems necessary. Every one is different, so proceed cautiously.

#### **How To Apply American Native Herbal Ointment**

1. With a sterilized needle prick around the affected area. Apply a sufficient amount of Ointment to cover the affected area. Apply a Un-petroleum Multi-purpose Jelly, to a Band-Aid, or piece of gauze and cover the area that you applied the ointment. Leave the ointment on for twelve (12) hours. Most people apply before bedtime and sleep through the biggest part of the time, as some people will experience pain. You will feel a burning sensation upon application and a dark scab will begin to form. If there is no diseased tissues, there will be no significant effect.

2. Remove the bandage after twelve (12) hours and rinse thoroughly with 3% hydrogen peroxide. If the ointment has penetrated the skin, there will be a red ring around the area, and the tissues will be grayish white. A degree of swelling indicates the herbs are at work.
